OFFICIAL INSTRUCTION and INVITATION

The European Sumo Federation and the Estonian Sumo Federation would like to invite your Federation to participate in the Official European Continental Sumo Championships 2018 /Younger Cadets, Cadets and Juniors/ in Rakvere, Estonia.

1. TITLE OF EVENT:

European Continental Cadets and Juniors Sumo Championships 2018

- Younger Cadets under 14 years (MU14/WU14) October, 26
- Cadets under 16 years (MU16/WU16) October, 27
- Juniors under 18 years (MU18/MU18) October, 28

2. **PURPOSE:** To develop and promote sumo in Europe and to establish mutual friendship and goodwill among participating countries. **The reunification of the European sumo family.**

3. **ORGANIZERS:** The European Sumo Federation (EFS) and **the Estonian Sumo Association**

4. SPONSORS and SUPPORTERS:

- Main sponsors: Estonian Ministry of Culture, Rakvere City Government, Gambling Tax Council and Cultural Endowment

5. **DATE OF COMPETITION:** **October 25-29, 2018**

6. COMPETITION VENUE, REGISTRATION ADDRESS and ACCREDITATION:

7. ELIGIBILITY:

- (1) All member countries of EFS and countries approved by European Sumo Federation.
- (2) Participants will be girl and boys born between the years of
 - 2004 to 2006 /U14/;
 - 2002 to 2005 /U16/.

- 2000 to 2004 /U18/

8. REGISTRATION OF ATHLETES:

- (1) The attached competition entry forms are to be filled in with capital letters and to be sent to the European Sumo Federation by e-mail riho.rannikmaa@eestisumo.ee. Applications will only be accepted on the official entry forms. Uncompleted forms will not be accepted.
- (2) The initial application deadline is **14th September 2018**. Here you must send an intention that your federation will participate in YESC 2018. **The final application deadline for athletes' participation is 15th October 2018**. All countries must register for all athletes, officials to the Youth European Continental Sumo Championships 2018 by the above-mentioned application date.
- (3) If after the closing date **Monday 15th October 2018 at 17:00** there are any changes whatsoever to the athlete's registrations, change of athlete, late entry, then a **double entry** fee will be charged. If athletes are cancelled after the closing date the entry fee must be paid and will not be refunded. All outstanding amounts must be paid full in cash before admittance to the championships.
- (4) All entries will only be accepted on the official EFS entry forms. (There will be no exceptions) and must arrive by the official closing dates.
- (5) **Site of accreditation, Draw and Weigh-in:**
For the accreditation only the delegation leader is requested to be present.
- (6) **Referee Seminar: 25th October 2018, 20:00 – 21:00**
All referees must obtain their EFS tournament licence 2018 at the seminar.
- (7) **Meeting of the members of the DC: 26th October 2018, 9:00 – 10:00**
- (8) At the official control of nations the names submitted are final and all fees paid at this time are not refundable whatsoever. If your delegation leader is not available to attend at this date and time then the last athlete change will be accepted by mail until 17:00h on **15th October 2018** to the office of the General Secretary

- (9) **Team list** with the names and start order must be entered no later than **60 minutes** before the start of the team tournament, this must be handed to the EFS Sports Director and all payments must be settled before that. The draw will then be made. Once the draw has been made no other team entries will be accepted. (This is only applicable for the Open)

9. TRAVEL EXPENSES:

- (1) Each individual Federation is responsible for the all travel costs incurred in the transportation including visa application.
- (2) All Federations requiring visas are kindly requested to apply well in advance minimum 25 days before the beginning of the tournament.
- (3) The organizer will provide a transport from Tallinn Airports to the hotels, sports hall and back.
- (4) All participating federations have to send by mail to the organizer the necessary travel details for arrival/departure to organizer by e-mail: riho.rannikmaa@eestisumo.ee

9. ACCOMMODATION and MEALS EXPENSES:

Official accommodation shall be 4 days 3 nights which start from the 25 to 28 October, The organiser provides accommodation in 3 price categories as follows:

Deadline for the hotel reservations is **25th September 2018**.

After this deadline, the price of the accommodation increases by EUR 10 for each categories of hotel

If participants do not use official accommodation provided by the organizer, they will be required to pay a fee of 200 € per person at accreditation.

10. COMPETITION RULES

1) The competition will be carried out according to the IFS regulations together with application of the double repechage system.

If there are 5 or less athletes in a weight group a pool system maybe used.

2) Mawashi (sumo belt) approved by the European Sumo Federation must be worn.

3) Male athletes of all age groups may wear only **black** tight underpants under mawashi. The length of the underpants must cover the whole thigh.

4) All female athletes must wrestle in a one-piece wrestling leotard plus mawashi. Women may not compete, wearing T-shirts.

Each contestant is responsible for bringing his own mawashi and underpants.

5) All mawashi must conform to international regulations, if not, it is possible that the mawashi will be invalid for the tournament and another mawashi may have to be used by the wrestler. If at the discretisation of the refereeing director a suitable substitute mawashi cannot be found and used within a reasonable amount of time, the athlete may have to forfeit the match. Also, all mawashi must be dry and not wet and made of recognised fabric.

6) Provided by the organizer country identification (Zekken) must be worn.

7) The team for the Team Competition /U16/U18 shall consist of 4 contestants: first (Senpo), second (Chuken), third (Taiso) and substitute. There will be no weight limits. A substitute may be used only once.

For the team event, there must be a minimum of two wrestlers.

8) **Age groups and weight categories**

Quantity of participants from a country as follows:

GIRLS (born 2004-2006) WU14:

-33kg (2); -36kg (2); -40kg (2); -45kg (2); -50kg (2); -55kg (2); -60kg (2); -65kg (2); +65kg (2);

BOYS (born 2004-2006) MU14:

-35kg (2); -40kg (2); -45kg (2); -50kg (2); -55kg (2); -60kg (2); -65kg (2); -70kg (2); +70kg (2).

GIRLS (born 2002-2005) WU16:

-45kg (2), -50kg (2), -55kg (2), -60kg (2), -65kg (2), +65kg (2), Team (1).

BOYS (born 2002-2005) MU16:

-55kg (2), -65kg (2), -75kg (2), -85kg (2), -95kg (2), +95kg (2), Team (1).

W/U18 (born 2000-2004):

-50kg (2), -55kg (2), -60kg (2), -65kg (2), -70kg (2), +70kg (2), Open (2); Team (1);

M/U18 (born 2000-2004):

-60kg (2), -70kg (2), -80kg (2), -90kg (2), -100kg (1), +100kg (2), Open (2); Team (1);

11. FINANCIAL REQUIREMENTS

Entry fee will be charged for all athletes mentioned in the official entry form.

For participants age groups U 14: **10 EUR** per wrestler in each weight category;

For participants age groups U 16 and U 18: **20 EUR** per wrestler in each weight category;

Team tournament /U16 and U18/: **50 EUR** per team

Annual membership fee for 2018: **150 EUR** per national sumo union

All fees are paid to the organizer at registration and accreditation upon arrival in cash only and are non-refundable.

12. SPECIAL NOTE

1. All visa applications must be sent to the Estonian Sumo Association before **28th September 2018**.
2. Tournament registration to be sent to the organizer only.
3. Compulsory Referee seminar on October 25, 2018 at 20:00-21:00. All referees must obtain their EFS tournament licence 2017 at the seminar.
4. By the control of nations there has to be at least one representative from the registered federation.
5. At the draw, there has to be one representative per federation. After the draw, there can be no changes made. If the representative misses the draw, no pretensions concerning the result of the draw will be accepted.
6. The organizers shall provide first aid for injuries sustained during the championships but shall not be held liable for such injuries or any other accidents. The organizer will not be able to treat any other ailments not due to injury (such as headache or stomach-ache). Consequently, each contestant or official must arrange personal travel insurance and insurance against illness, death and accident.
