OPEN TIME & DATE:

Accreditation and Weigh-ins:

Accreditation will be held at the same venue as the open the evening before the open between 6.30PM and 9.15PM, Friday August 2nd

There will be 2 opportunities to weigh in at the venue, The first being between: 6.30pm to 9.15pm Friday the 2nd of August during accreditation and the morning of the open from 8.00AM to 8.45AM

Opening Ceremony 9.00am/9.25am where we will have a Scottish Bagpiper to play the athletes in.

Bouts begin from 9.30am or before.

We will also have a MINI JAPANESE MARKET set up with a few stalls which will open at 9.30AM and remain open until 4.30PM! Where you can view and even buy handmade Japanese items, crafts, Origami, Bolo stitching, Japanese calligraphy and much more, our amazing stall runners will also do their very best to engage with athletes and spectators alike to teach everyone more about Japanese AND Scottish culture!

We will try to break at 12.00pm, where we will have some entertainment.

ATHLETE NUMBERS AND LIMITS:

We will be accepting 3 athletes per category per country for 2024's Open! Athletes can enter

- Their own weight category
- The open weight category

ENTRY FEES AND DEADLINE:

£25 registration fee for each country.£20 per athlete entry fee.£20 per entry to the openweight.

- ENTRIES MUST BE CONFIRMED BY FRIDAY JUNE 28TH 2024
- ATHLETE NAMES MUST BE CONFIRMED BY FRIDAY JULY 5TH 2024! ***Entry fees can be paid in advance Clan sumo scotland's bank account or Paypal account on request for details, this way will make for a smoother registration,

We would prefer registration fees be paid ahead of time this way as a sign of good faith for attendance, If you would like to pay in cash in person please inform us well in advance before the entries deadline thank you***

CATEGORIES:

In order in which the categories will compete:

U18 women (must be over 16 years old) Openweight Other Categories for U18 women will be added and determined depending on confirmed numbers of participants!

U18 men (must be over 16 years old) Openweight Other Categories for U18 men will be added and determined depending on confirmed numbers of participants!

Seniors Born 2006 or above: Women: -50kg, -55kg, -65 kg, -73kg, -80 kg, +80 kg, Open

Mens: -70 kg, -77kg, -85 kg, -92kg, -100 kg, -115 kg, +115 kg, Open

IMPORTANT:

(All categories are subject to change depending on entry numbers, The categories being held for the open will be finalised when entry numbers are confirmed)

COMPETING SCENARIOS:

If there are five or fewer competitors in a category, then a round robin system will be in place.

If there are more than five to a category, competitors will be split into groups, and the winners of each group will go through to compete for the podium spots in a playoff scenario.

Open weight is a straight knock out scenario!

(Again please note could be subject to change depending on numbers of athletes who attend)

REFEREE'S & JUDGES:

We are happy to announce that last year's Scottish open Head Gyoji/judge Polish Sumo President Kewin Rozum has agreed to return for year 2 and lead the referees once again!

Please note:

National federations (or the referee themselves) will also have to cover costs of travel and accommodation.

ATHLETE COMPETING ATTIRE:

All competitors must wear a mawashi.

Male competitors can wear skin tight Nylon/Spandex cycling type shorts or can wear their mawashi alone, this is the individual athlete's choice. All female competitors must wear a Unitard/Leotard one piece.

ACCOMMODATION:

Athletes are responsible for arranging their own accommodation but for those who may need assistance we will be happy to help you look for and help set this up if required.

(please inform us if you need help with organising Accommodation AS SOON AS POSSIBLE)

FLIGHTS:

Athletes are responsible for arranging their own flights, but we can also provide direction and advice with this as well.

The closest airports to the venue are: Glasgow airport and Edinburgh airport. We can arrange transport for athletes from the airport to your hotel for a fee of £25 per athlete!

AFTER PARTY:

After party details will be released closer to the date of the open once numbers are confirmed.

All athletes who confirm their entry will be sent the following once we have your accommodation location:

- A map of bus and train stations and routes that take you to your hotel from your airport.
- A map from your accommodation to the venue for the open.
- A map from your hotel to the international practice sessions dojo.
- A list of local taxi cab companies.

- A list of local shops, cafes and restaurants in the surrounding area your accommodation is in.
- Things to visit and see in the surrounding areas if you plan on staying in Scotland longer than the open weekend!
- A map to the nearest hospitals and doctors' offices.
- A list of important phone numbers for these services in the area of your accommodation.
